Academic entry requirements

BU International College Foundation Certificates

You can undertake a Foundation Certificate before going on to an undergraduate course if you have 12 years of schooling in France and achieved a minimum of IELTS (Academic) 5.0.

Undergraduate courses (Bachelor's degree)

You can apply to study a Bachelor's degree from year one if you hold a Baccalauréat, a Baccalauréat avec Option Internationale, a Brevet de Maîtrise, or a Brevet de Technicien (BT).

If you have a Diplôme Universitaire de Technologie, a Brevet de Technicien Supérieur, or a Diplôme d'Etat de Technicien (two years), you can apply for a Top-up course.

Postgraduate courses (Master's degree)

You can apply for a taught postgraduate course with us if you have a Diplôme, a Maîtrise (pre-2009), or a Licence.

Research programmes

You need a Master's degree to be considered for a BU research programme.

English entry requirements

Undergraduate and postgraduate

IELTS Academic (UKVI or non-UKVI) 6.0 with a minimum of 5.5 in each component.

If you have achieved a mark of 14 (bien) in English, where the co-efficient applied to the subject is greater than 1 in English as part of the Baccalauréat de l'Enseignement du Second Degré qualification (a mark of 12 may be accepted in some circumstances).

Scholarships

Undergraduate

We award a £2,500 Academic Excellence Scholarship to you automatically if you have achieved French Baccalauréat 13, French International Option Bac. 12 or equivalent.

Postgraduate

We award a £3,500 Academic Excellence Scholarship to you automatically if you achieved Licence/Grade de Licence/Maitrise with 14 points with "Bien" or equivalent.

Accommodation

We offer a number of safe and modern rooms in our halls of residence for students to live in.

Prices range from £134 to £170 per week and most apartments come with five to six en-suite rooms, and a shared kitchen space. We also offer a limited number of studio rooms in our halls of residence, which are priced separately. Our halls are conveniently located near supermarkets and bus stops to enhance ease of access.

Halls of residence have weekly organised activities, common rooms to enjoy evenings with friends, and 24/7 support services. Accommodation is available for both September and January starters.

1 Prepare

Prepare your application documents

In order to make an application you will need to prepare the required documents. These include qualification transcripts and certificates, your personal statement, academic references, and your most recent English qualification. 2 Apply

Make your application to BU

Applications for undergraduate courses are made via UCAS. Please visit www.bournemouth.ac.uk/apply for more information. 3 Offer

Receive an offer

BU aims to make you an offer within two weeks of a fully completed application. Courses requiring additional selection measures such as interviews may take a little longer. You will be issued with a conditional offer (if you are still completing a qualification) or an unconditional offer (if you have met all entry requirements for your course).

4 Accept

Confirm your offer

To confirm your place at BU, you will need to accept your offer on myHub. You will also need to pay a deposit to secure your place if you are an international applicant. If your offer is conditional, you will also need to upload any final documents required.

5 Confirm

Confirmation of Acceptance of Studies (CAS)

International applicants will receive a request from BU asking for certain details (such as a current passport) which are required to issue a CAS. Applicants who require a Student Route visa to study in the UK will be issued a CAS once they have paid a deposit. CAS are issued from six months before the course starts.

6 Prepare
