End Point Assessment

This award is an integrated degree apprenticeship and includes an end-point assessment (EPA) which the apprentice must pass to complete the programme.

The EPA period must only start once the employer and BU are satisfied that the apprentice is demonstrating the knowledge, skills and behaviours of the apprenticeship standard, and all of the pre-requisite gateway requirements for EPA as defined in the assessment plan and apprenticeship funding rules have been met.

AIMS OF THE DOCUMENT

The aims of this document are to:

- define the structure of the programme;
- specify the programme award titles;
- articulate how the programme will enable apprentices to demonstrate the Knowledge, Skills and Behaviours of the apprenticeship standard;
- identify programme and level learning outcomes;
- articulate the regulations governing the awards defined within the document.

AIMS OF THE PROGRAMME

Operating Department Practice is a Higher Education programme that has been delivered by Bournemouth University since 2003. The programme represents the bringing together of both national and university requirements that have been informed and developed by Bournemouth University's Perioperative Practice and Education Forum, learners, alumni, service users/carers and the perioperative academic team. The curriculum offers learners support and opportunities to be successful in graduating as competent and confident professionals who can take on the highest level of responsibility to act as custodians of patients as they care for them during a time when they have lost their usual freedoms. Graduates will know how to care with skill, morals and ownership to protect the patient with dignified care before handing the body back to the patient or transferring custodianship to others. They will meet the challenge of working collaboratively with colleagues and patients and recognise the importance of working independently with a strong professional identity that enables them to adapt to a range of healthcare settings and confidently embrace emerging new ways of working in the high-technology operating department.

The HCPC Standards of Proficiency for ODPs and the ODP apprenticeship standard are explicit through the curriculum to provide ongoing support for developing familiarity and recognising the importance of what perioperative practice is. The curriculum is constructed to support employers to develop their staff to meet their workforce needs whilst recognising the broader aspects of being a graduate.

Overall, this programme aims to develop critically informed, agile and resourceful graduates, who:

- Develop an understanding of their current role as a critical thinker that maintains practice in light of current evidence.
- Undertake a life-long approach to learning and the skills to inform themselves and others concerning developing good practice to enhance their care of others.
- Demonstrate fitness for registration with the appropriate professional body through compassionate and intelligent care that celebrates the diversity and individuality of humanised care.
- · Act as ambassadors for high professional standards and values.
- Practice perioperative care in a consistently competent, highly skilled and safe manner.

ALIGNMENT WITH THE UNIVERSITY'S STRATEGIC PLAN

A regional skills need has been identified by our employer partners for an ODP apprenticeship as part of the NHS Long Term Workforce Plan. The need for offering more health apprenticeships is supported by the <u>Dorset Local Skills Improvement Plan</u>. The plan identifies that health is Dorset's biggest employment sector (55,000 staff) being the largest part of the labour market (16.3%) versus in England (13.3%). It is forecast to be Dorset's biggest employment growth sector. The number of ODP apprenticeship starts nationally has increased rapidly from 2018/19 with 30 starts to 377 starts in 2021/22. However, starts have plateaued with 390 starts in 2022/23. BU's 'region' includes East Somerset, Dorset, South Wiltshire and Hampshire which provides a large catchment to rapidly grow the number of starts for this standard. The closest provider of this standard is the University of West London which is over 100 miles from Bournemouth.

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Programme Specification - Section 2

The proposed new standard aligns with BU's strategic aim. Our aim for apprenticeships are to: respond to employer demand to deliver a curriculum that meets their specific needs; strengthen the workforce meeting national and regional workforce challenges by providing high quality, skilled apprentices ready for the workplace, while providing new diverse routes in and out of learning; build on well-established employer relationships; build on our strategic partnerships with University Hospitals Dorset (UHD) and Dorset Healthcare University NHS Foundation Trust which supports initiatives across research, education and practice in the region, helping people to live better for longer.

LEARNING HOURS AND ASSESSMENT

Bournemouth University taught programmes are composed of units of study, which are assigned a credit value indicating the amount of learning undertaken. In this programme, the credit value of each unit is 20 credits. 20 credits is the equivalent of 200 study hours required of the apprentice, including lectures, seminars, assessment and independent study. 20 University credits are equivalent to 10 European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) credits.

Typically, every level in the programme has three units with 40 contact hours each (including skills sessions) and three units with 30 contact hours (no skills sessions). Apprentices have three units, in each level, that include learning and assessing in the practice-based learning (PBL) setting, typically these are allocated learning as described below:

Level 4 – three PBL blocks totalling 720 clinical hours.

Level 5 – three PBL blocks totalling 795 clinical hours.

Level 6 – three PBL blocks totalling 684 clinical hours.

Moreover, each unit has additional hours dedicated to assessment (exam, coursework, presentation, practice assessment).

The Operating Department Practice apprenticeship programme aims to promote a holistic and effective learning experience for apprentices, and the assessments are crucial to achieving this. Different types of assessments challenge learners to develop a wide range of skills, ensuring that different types of learners can demonstrate their understanding and knowledge effectively. Key to this is using assessment *for* learning as well as assessment *of* learning. This is enabled through the range of assessments that look to develop intellectual ability, dissemination skills, critical thinking, use of literature and integration of theory and practice. Assessments allow for capable learners to be stretched and for struggling learners to be identified and supported. Additionally, the wide range of approaches to assessment, added to learning in clinical areas, mirror the real-world scenarios and better prepare apprentices in their career. Key to the assessments is that they take on the responsibility of ensuring apprentices are able to demonstrate they meet the knowledge, skills and behaviours and thereby can demonstrate how they are achieving the HCPC standards of proficiency.

Assessment strategies are likely to include written assignments, examinations (unseen and open book), OSCEs, inter-professional group work, posters, presentations, VIVA VOCE, patchwork, and portfolio. Feedback aims to not only clarify achievement but to also promote reflection and support the apprentices' personal development journey.

Clinical practice will be assessed using the practice assessment tool which draws from the Knowledge, Skills and behaviours and the HCPC Standards of Proficiency for Operating Department Practitioners, so that all apprentices are measured against national standards in the hospital setting to determine an individual's ability by relevant practice supervisors and practice assessor.

STAFF DELIVERING THE PROGRAMME

Apprentices will usually be taught by the perioperative practice academic team in combination with others who have relevant expertise including – where appropriate according to the content of the unit – academic staff from different teams, qualified professional practitioners, demonstrators/technicians, librarians, learning support, careers and so forth.

- The requirement to satisfy criminal conviction checks with the Disclosure and Barring Service at an enhanced level. See policy <u>3E-admissions-policy-and-procedure-for-applicants-with-a-criminal-record.pdf</u> (bournemouth.ac.uk)
- The requirement to satisfy health checks by learner self-declaration, GP statements or Occupational Health reports and to receive or follow guidance from Occupational Health, as per national standards, for exposure prone procedures.
- English/Maths requirements:
 - GCSE English Language or English Literature and Mathematics grade 4 (or grade C in the old grading system).
 - Other Level 2 equivalent qualifications must meet the acceptable qualifications for English and maths requirements for apprenticeships defined by the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) at level 2 and above.

The regulations for this programme are the University's Standard Undergraduate Assessment Regulations (https://intranetsp.bournemouth.ac.uk/pandptest/6a-standard-assessment-regulations-undergraduate.pdf) with the following approved exceptions:

Pass Mark (section 6): Where a unit contains an assessment element, defined as practice assessment, a pass will be awarded where each separate practice element is not less than 40%. Where a practice element has separate components, a fail in any one component will result in a mark of 0% being awarded for that element.

Compensation (section 7): Compensation does not apply to any practice-based units in this programme.

Awards (section 10): Certificate HE, DipHE, BSc, and Aegrotat awards will not confer eligibility to apply for registration with the Health and Care Professions Council and will be titled 'Perioperative Studies'.

Provision for failed candidates (section 12): Carrying credit is not permitted for any practice-based units.

External Examiners: To meet the requirements of the Health and Care Professions Council, at least one external examiner for the programme must be appropriately experienced/qualified and be registered on the relevant part of a statutory professional register.
